


# New Life in the Church

1. Why did God make human beings? (4)

**God made us to live united with him now and forever.**



2. Explain sin in two ways. (5)

**Sin is doing what we know is wrong. Sin is when we don't live united with God, through prayer, for example.**




3. What does Theotokos mean? Who is the Theotokos? (Teach with Nativity)

**“Theotokos” means “God-bearer.” Mary, the Mother of God, is the Theotokos.**




4. What do we receive in the first part of the Divine Liturgy? (13)

**We receive the lessons to teach us how to live. We receive the lessons in the Epistle, the Gospel, and the Sermon.**



5. Why do we come to Divine Liturgy? (19)

**We come to offer ourselves and the world to God. We come to have communion (union) with God and our brothers and sisters in Christ.**



6. Do we worship, or venerate, icons? What does the word, “venerate,” mean? (21)

**We venerate icons. This means we show great honor and respect to them.**



7. Which Gospel passage tells us what we must do to go to heaven? What is one thing we must do? (23)

**The Gospel passage that tells us what we must do to go to heaven is the story of the sheep and goats that come before God at the end of the world. We must feed the hungry; clothe the naked; give drink to the thirsty; visit those in prison; visit the sick; and welcome a stranger.**



8. In whose image are we made? What is another word for image? How should we treat each person? (23)

**Each person is made in God's image.**

**Another word for image is “icon.”**

**We should treat every person with kindness and compassion because each person is an icon of God.**
